5. Tech Official Report

Training Updates:

- o Additional training on NTPA certification for roll cages is being pursued.
- o Recommendations for future safety courses were discussed.

• Safety Rule Changes Proposed:

1. Add turbo blankets to chargers 2.5" intake diameter or larger (all classes).

Motion made by Byron McGrath to move to 3" intake diameter (all classes).

- All clubs in favor.
- 2. No more plates for clutch/flywheel protection only SFI-certified scatter blankets are accepted.

Motion made by Kirby Densmore that no more plates be used for clutch/flywheel protection. Only a certified SFI scatter blanket or SFI bellhousing will be accepted for any class that requires clutch protection currently.

5. Fire suits, harnesses, scatter blankets, boots, and neck braces must be replaced if expired.

Scott brought this to everyone's attention for 2025. We will revisit at 2025 AGM after Scott has done further research into expiries of the different equipment.

Woodstock – Encourages all clubs to adapt the PEI lanyard idea from 2024.

-Discussion was had on our current points system and how we can avoid so many ties in the future.

Motion by Ricky Balsor to leave the points as is for 2025. Seconded by Brandon Best. All clubs in favor.

Crapaud - Jamie and Jason thanks for attendance and accepting the changes to the event grounds. More changes coming, thanks to the pullers for embracing these changes.

-Dyno Safety

• Pullers will be responsible for hooking on and removing the PTO drive shaft. If this is done by a pullers helper the tractor will need to be shut off during hooking up or unhooking the dyno. The dyno operator will supervise. (this is necessary to make sure we avoid injuries)

Motion by Jason Webster to enforce the above as written. Seconded by Kirby Densmore. All clubs in favor.

All tractor operators will be responsible for making sure their tractor's PTO shaft
will accept the MTTPA dyno and our adapters. This means if your PTO requires a
hammer to get our dyno hooked then it will be rejected. (We cannot have
equipment damaged because tractor PTO shafts are not maintained. If you need to
file you shaft it should be done before you come to the track)

Motion by Jason Webster to accept the above as written. Seconded by Kirby Densmore. All clubs in favor.

10. New Business

- Kirby Densmore brought forward the need for a scale operator at each event for the lawn tractors.
- Jon Visser brought forward the need for increased lawn tractor safety.
- Document was reviewed for changes to the 7200LB Modified tractor class.

Motion by Ricky Balsor to adapt proposed changes on the attached document. Seconded by Adam Lawrence. Motion was tabled until next year's AGM by the clubs.
